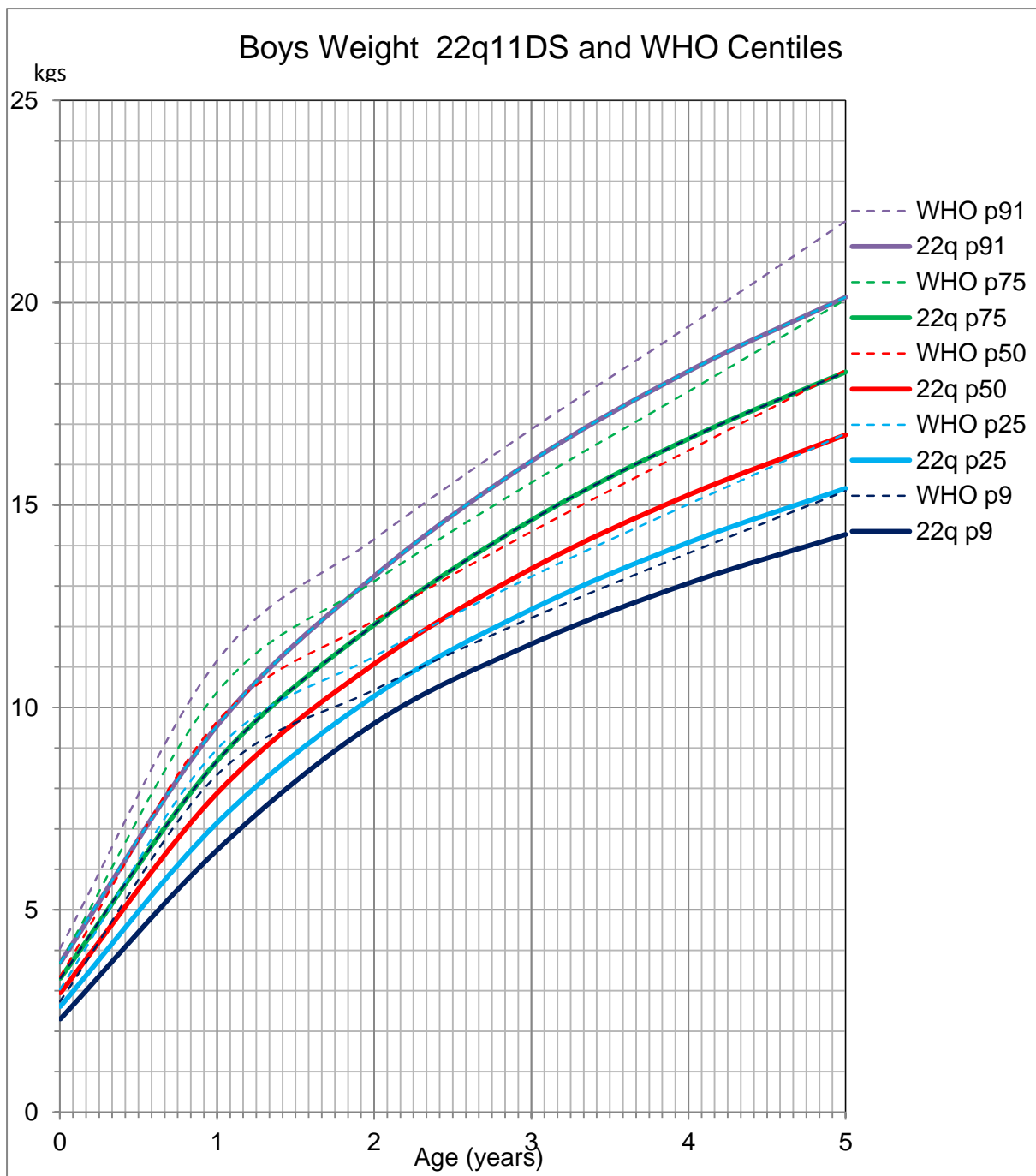


## GROWTH CHARTS FOR 22q11 DELETION SYNDROME

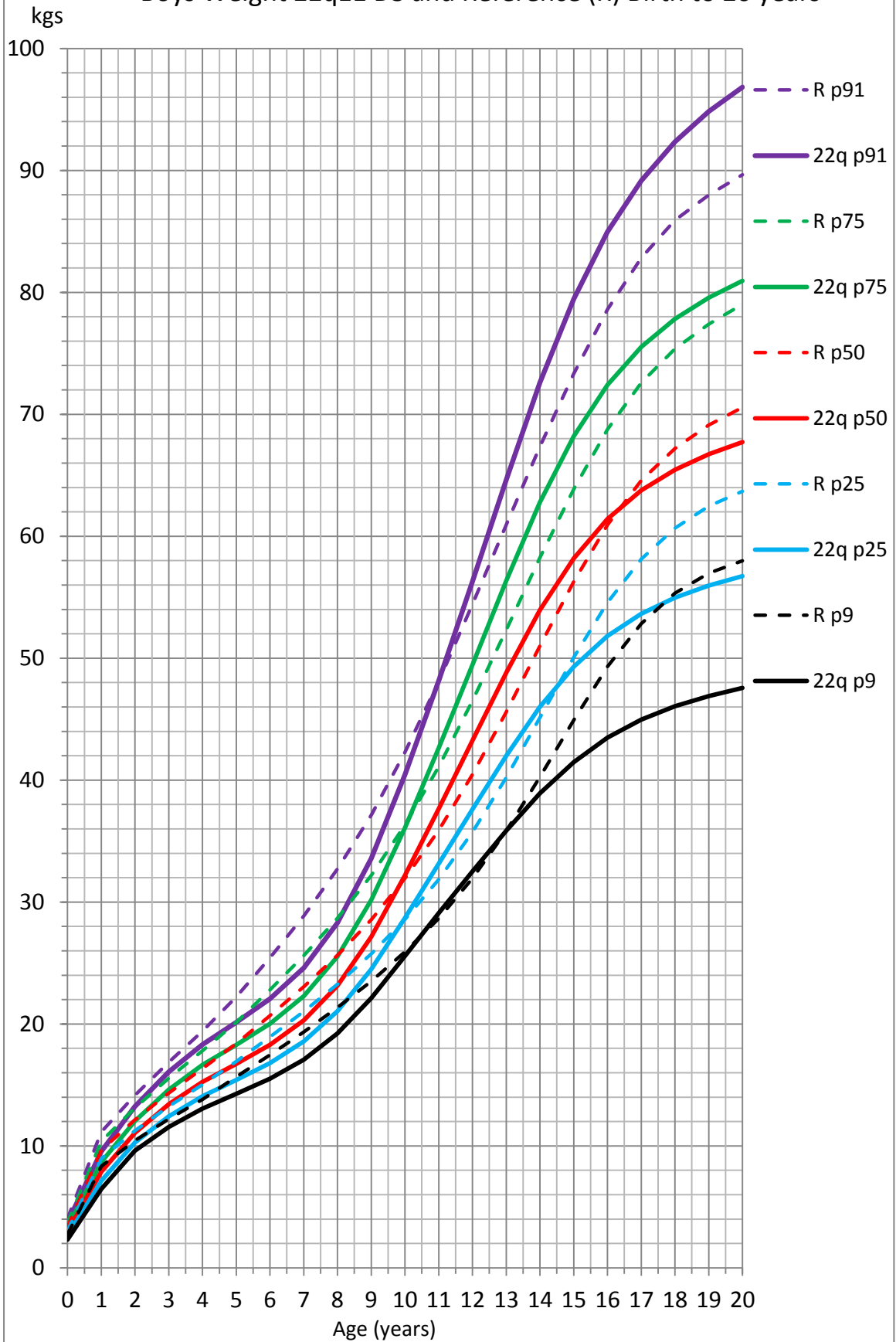
Five centile (9<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup>, 50<sup>th</sup>, 75<sup>th</sup>, 91<sup>st</sup>) lines for weight, height, body mass index (BMI) and head circumference.

22q11 Deletion Syndrome (22q11DS) solid lines, US and UK Reference (R) dotted lines.

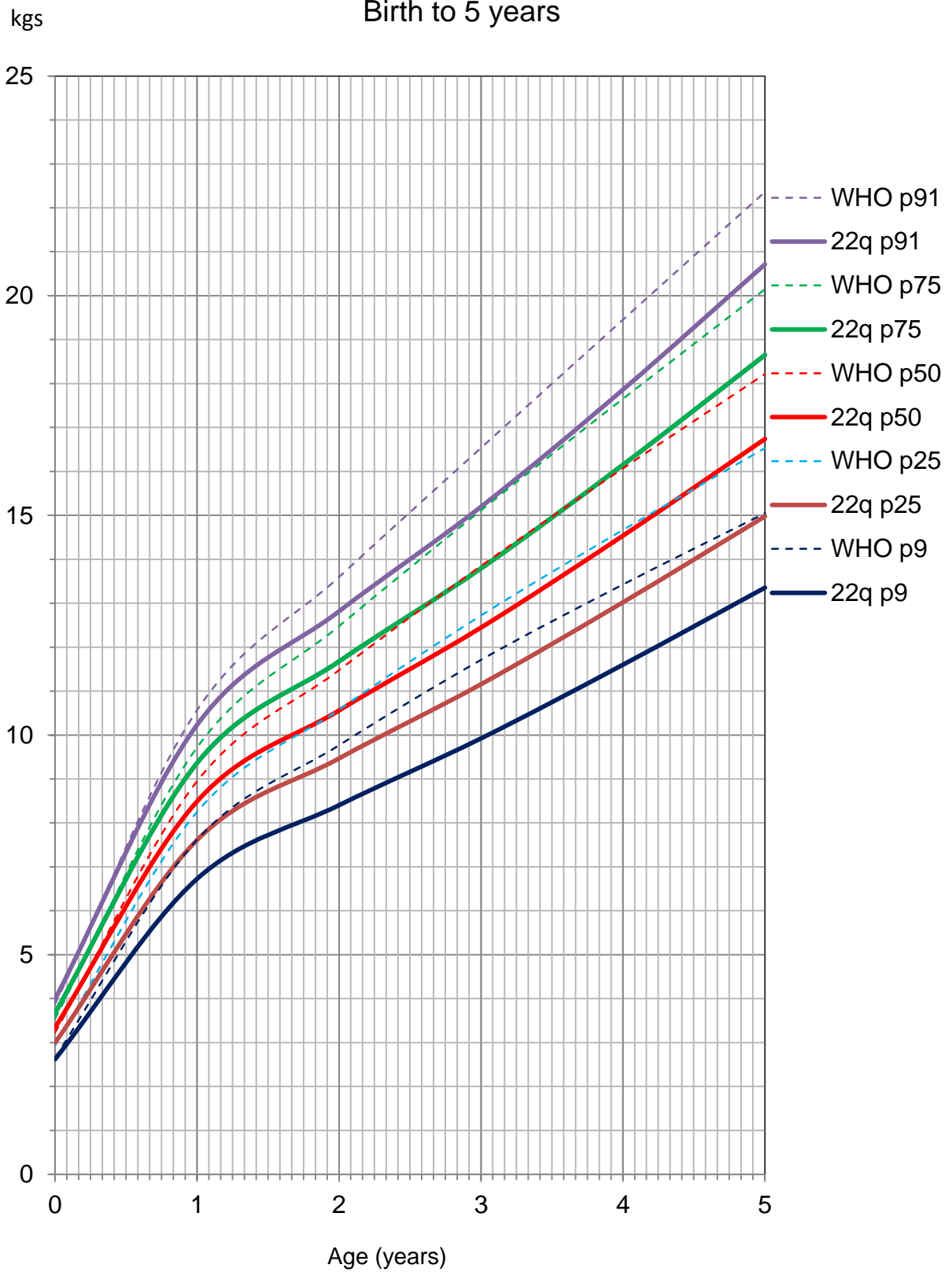
Weight, height and BMI plotted against WHO Reference centiles birth - 5 years alone and combined with US CDC 2000 Reference centiles 5 - 20 years. Head circumference plotted against WHO Reference centiles birth - 5 years alone and combined with UK Reference centiles 5 - 20 years, used as US Reference only covers birth – 3 years.



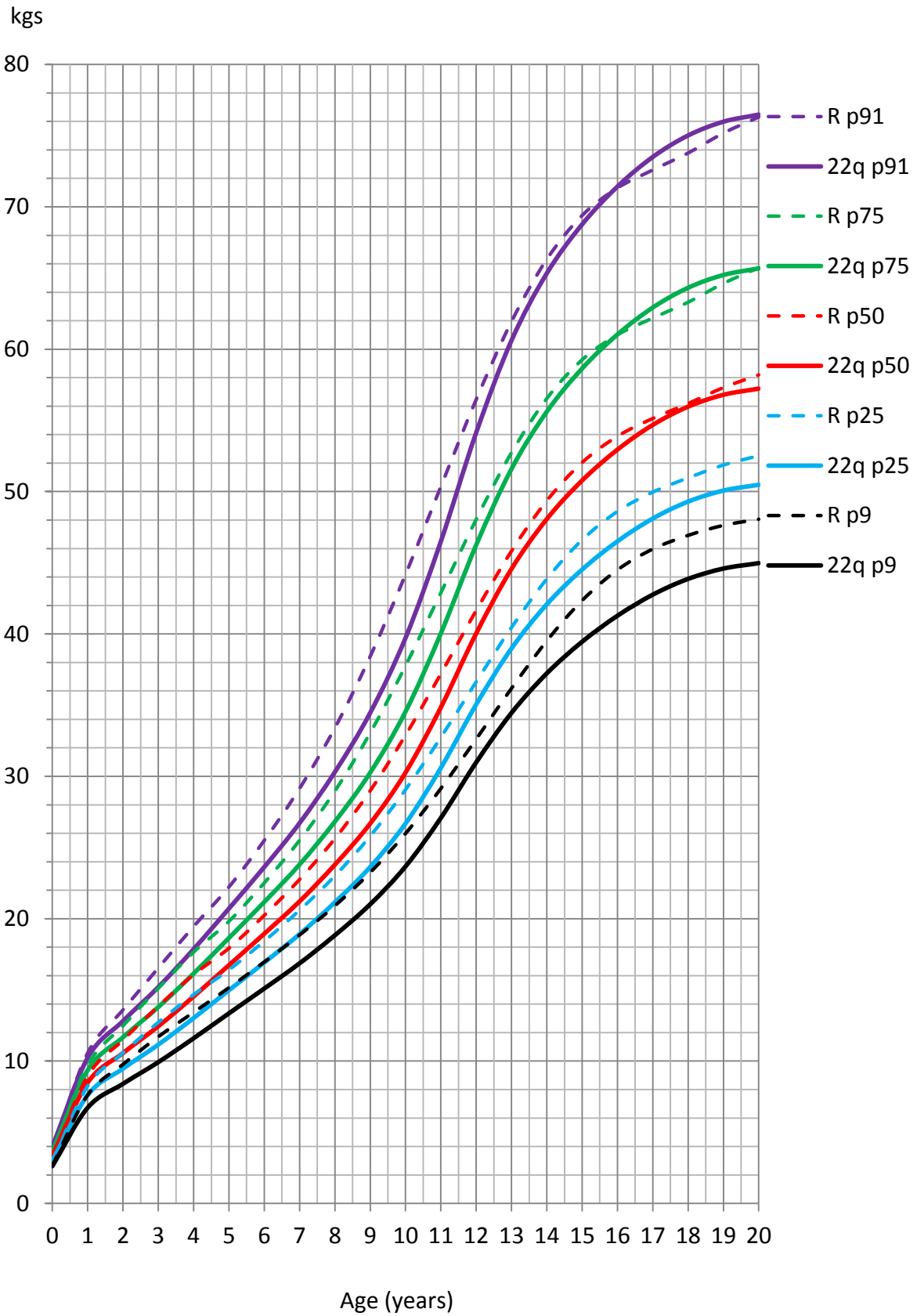
Boys Weight 22q11 DS and Reference (R) Birth to 20 years



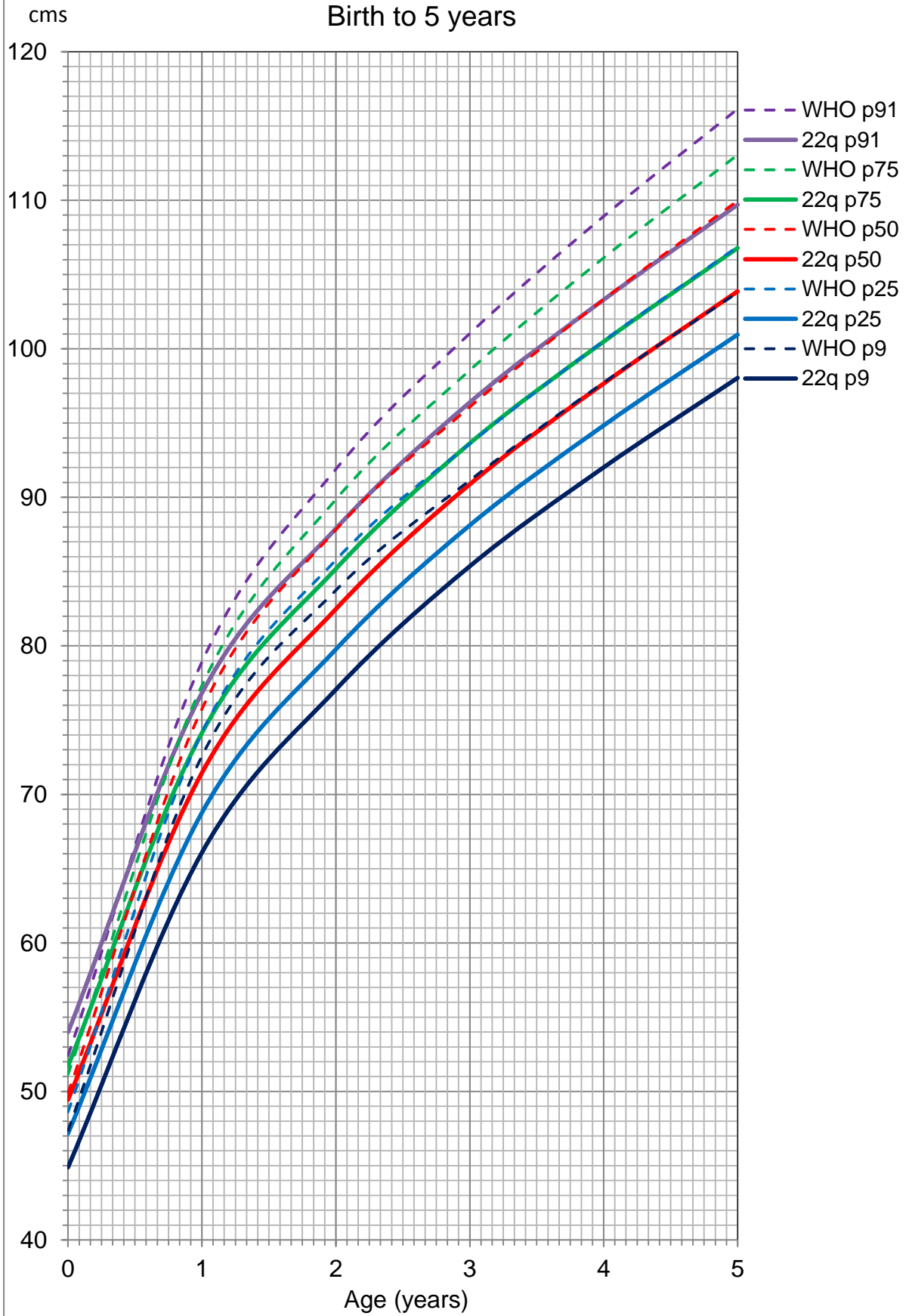
Girls Weight 22q11 DS and WHO Centiles  
Birth to 5 years

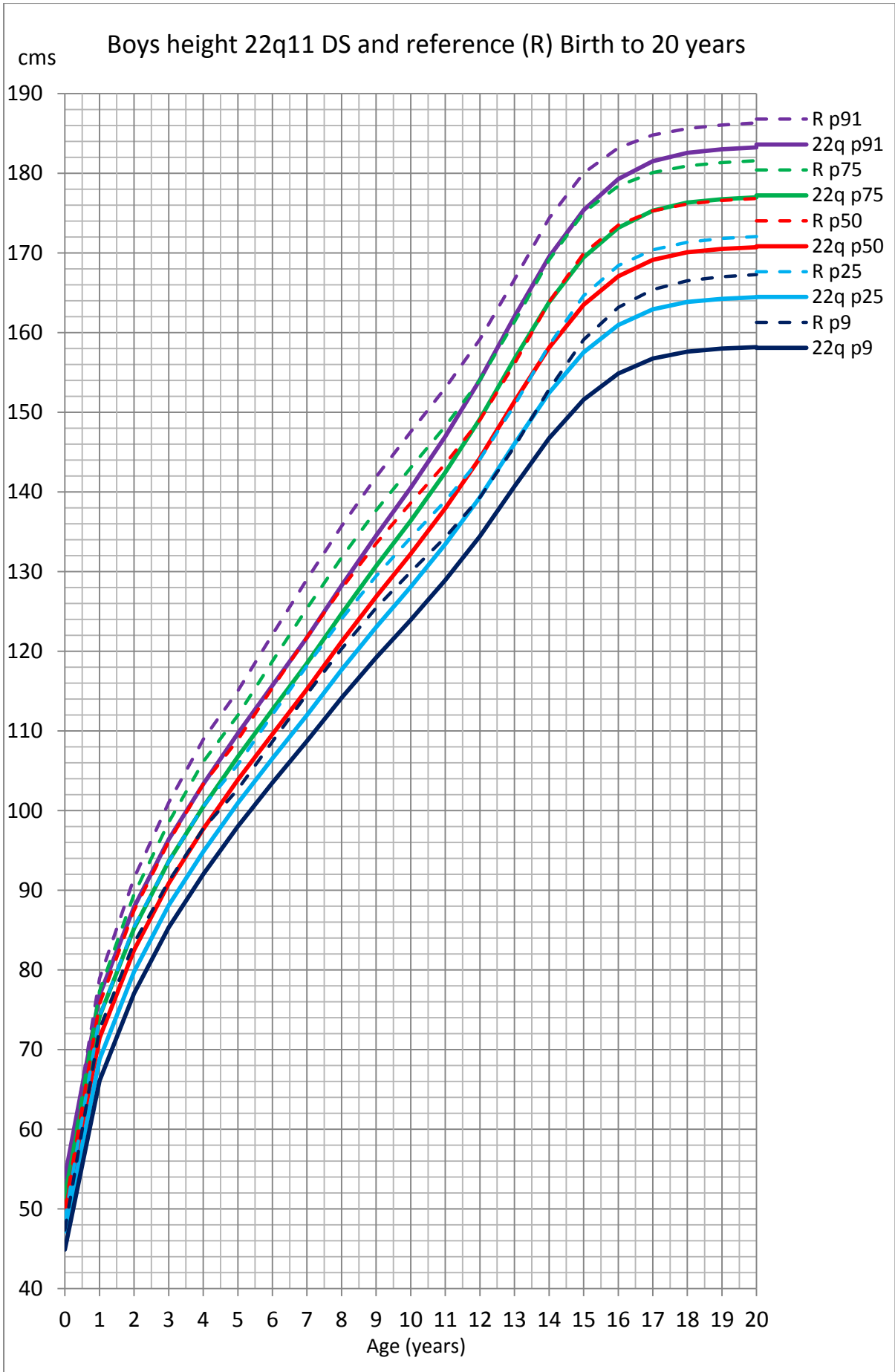


Girls Weight 22q11 DS and Reference (R) Birth to 20 years

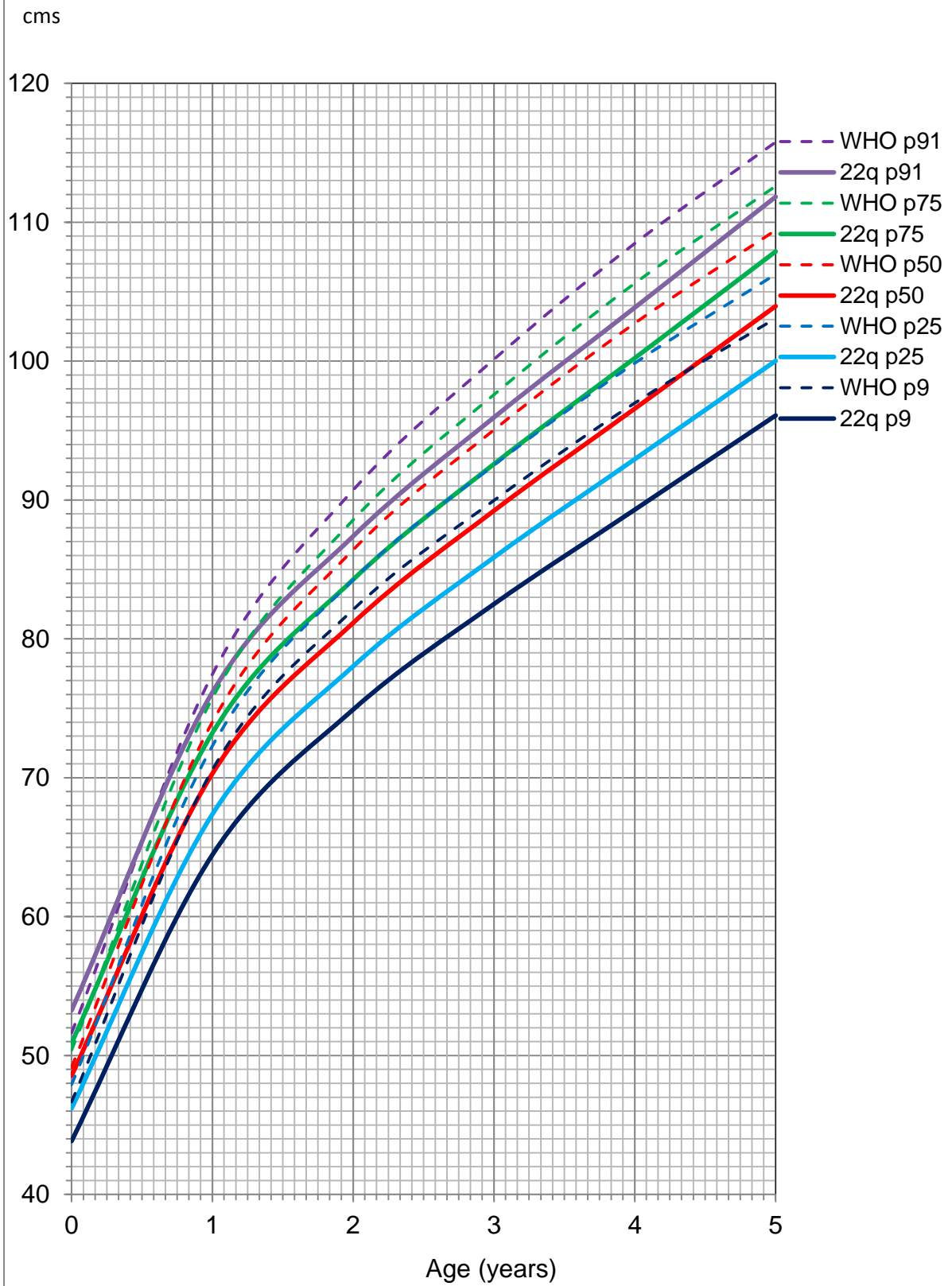


Boys Height 22q11 DS and WHO Centiles  
Birth to 5 years

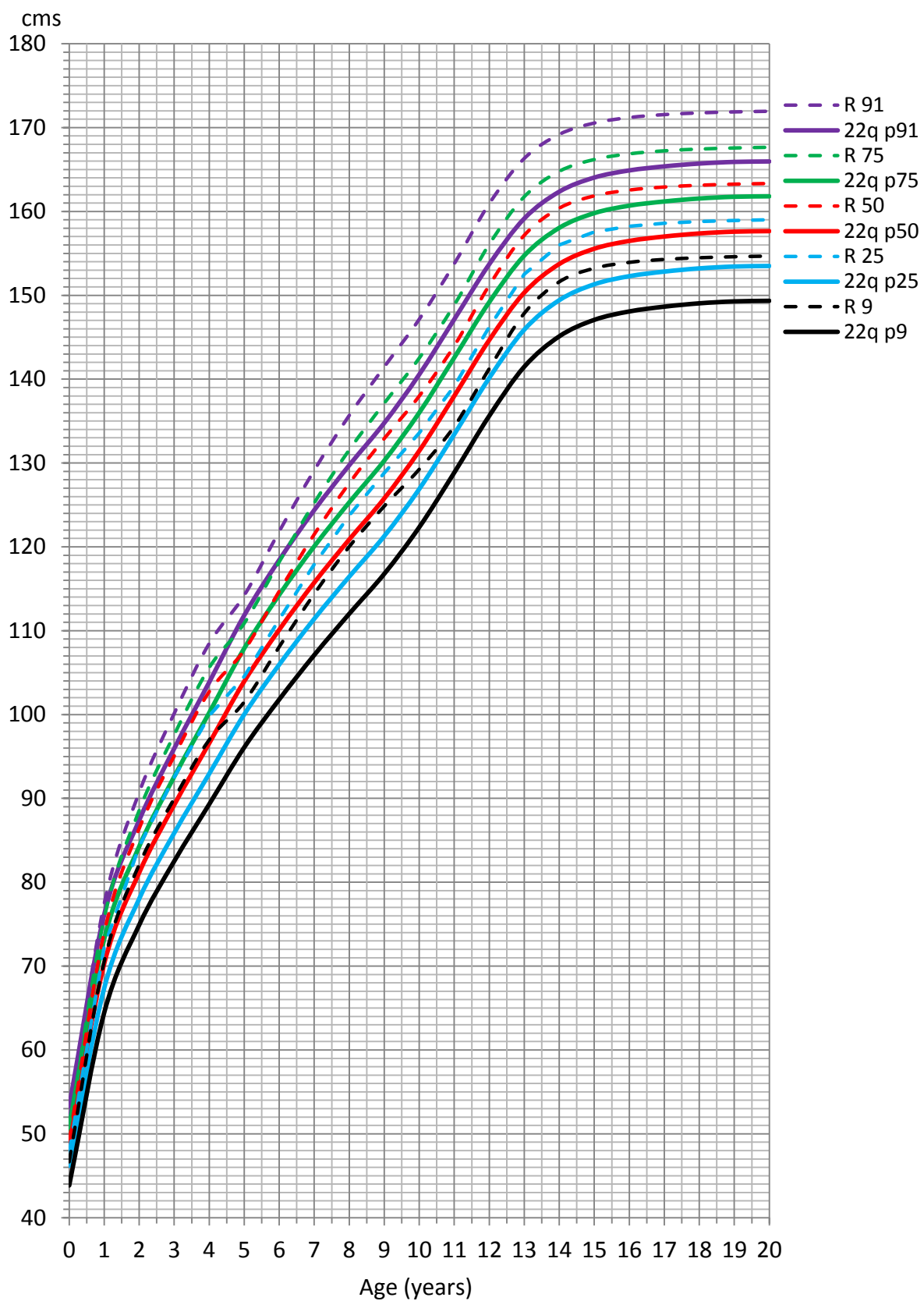




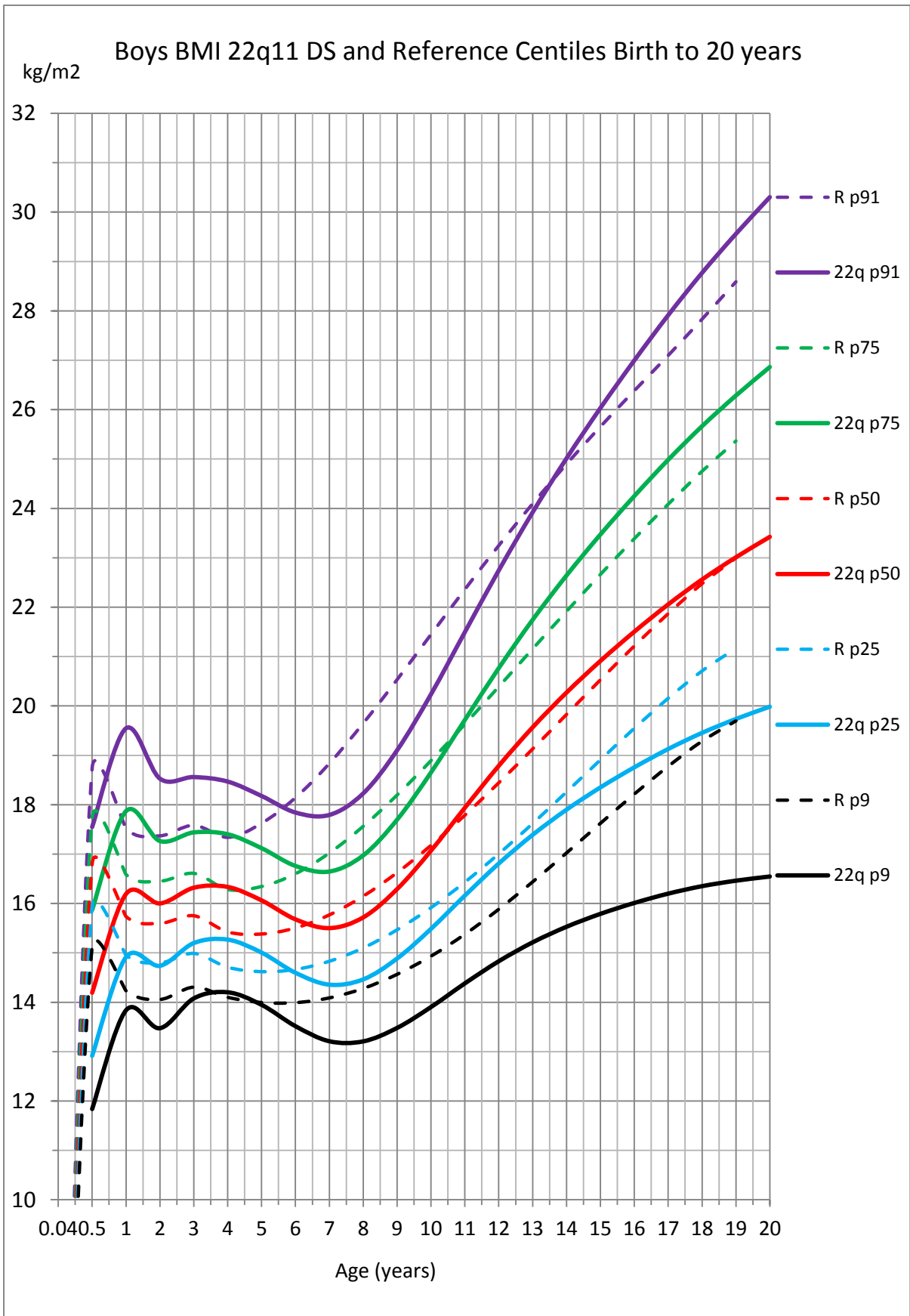
# Girls Height 22q11 DS and WHO Centiles Birth to 5 years

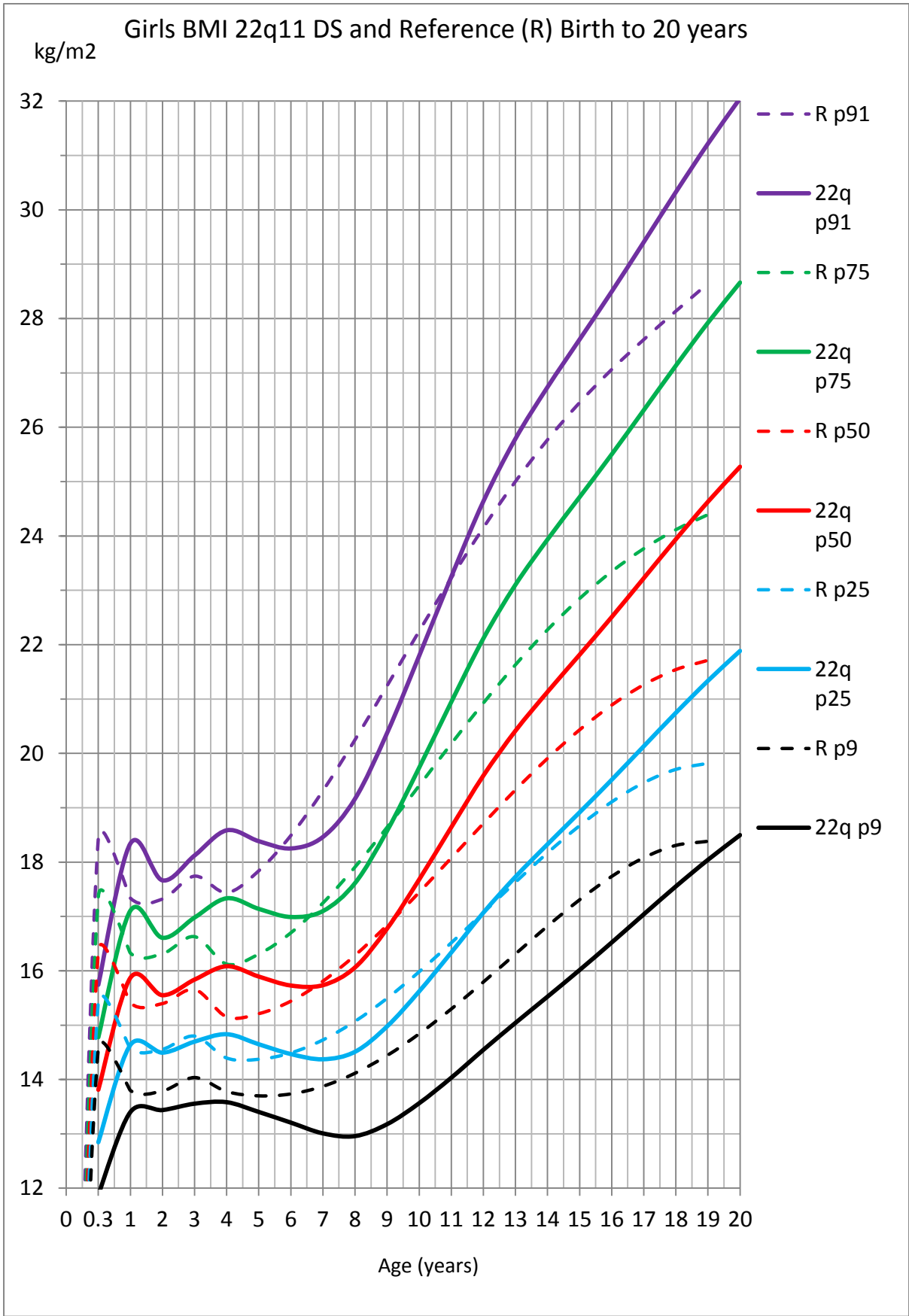


Girls Height 22q11 DS and Reference Centiles Birth to 20 years

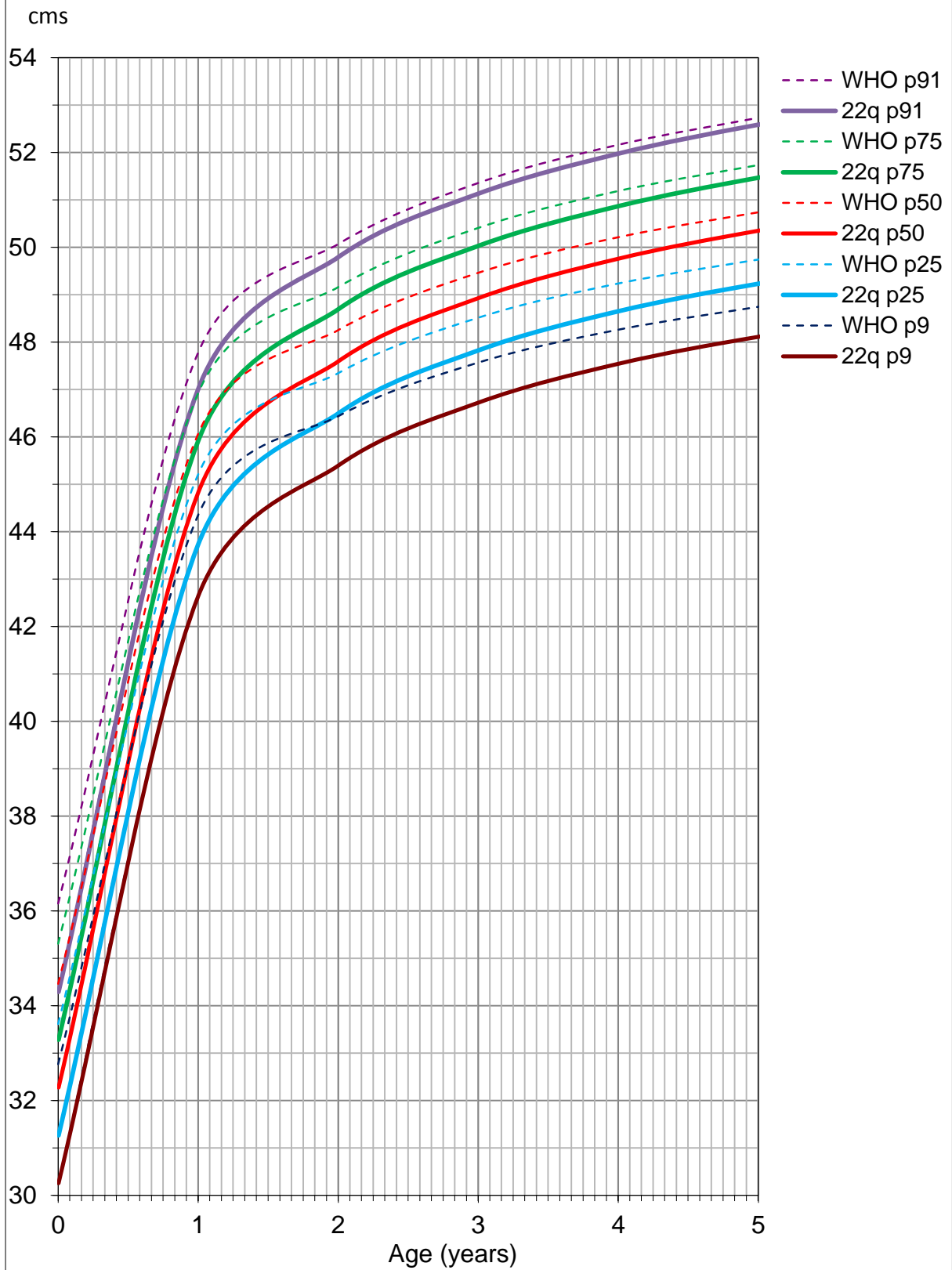


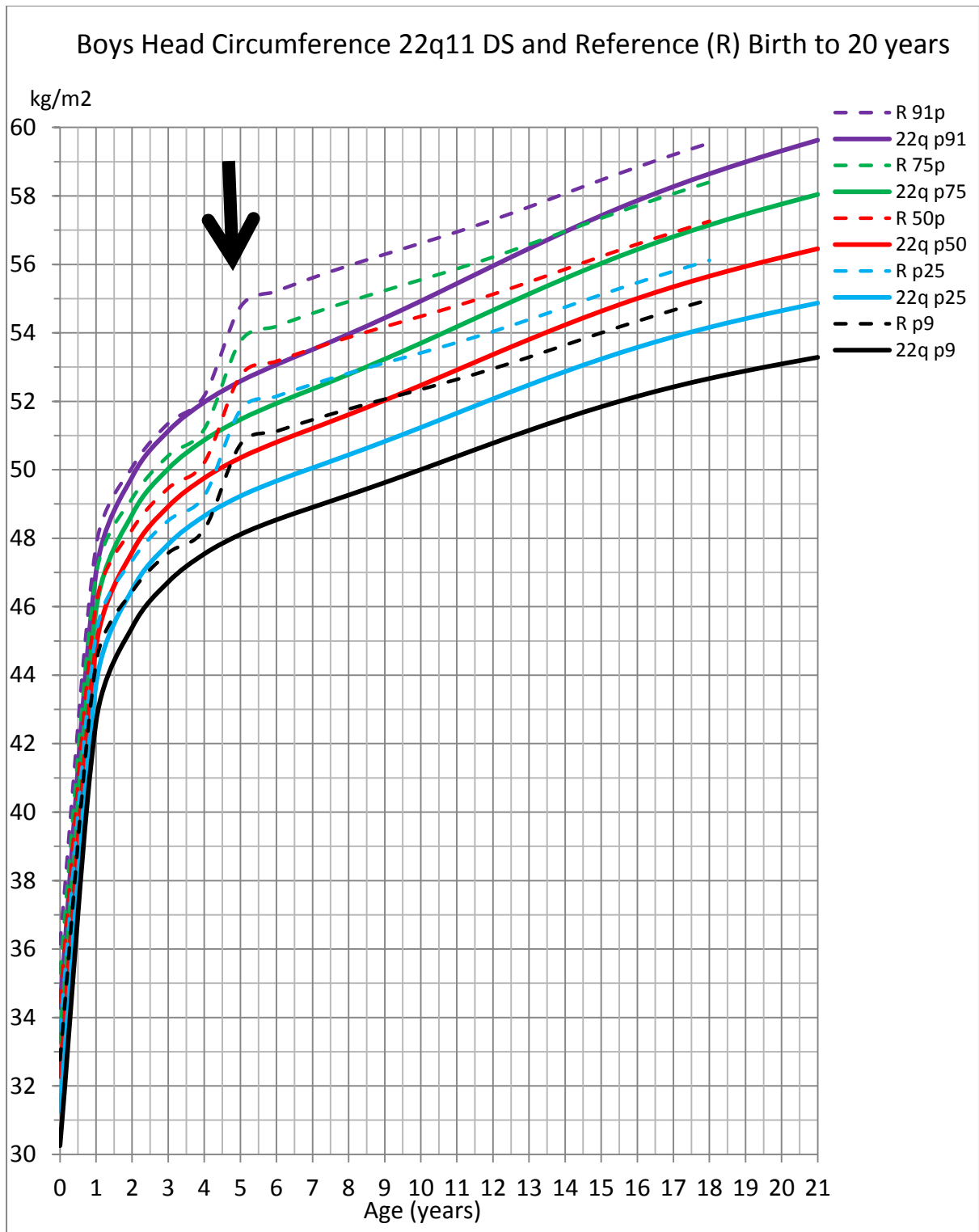






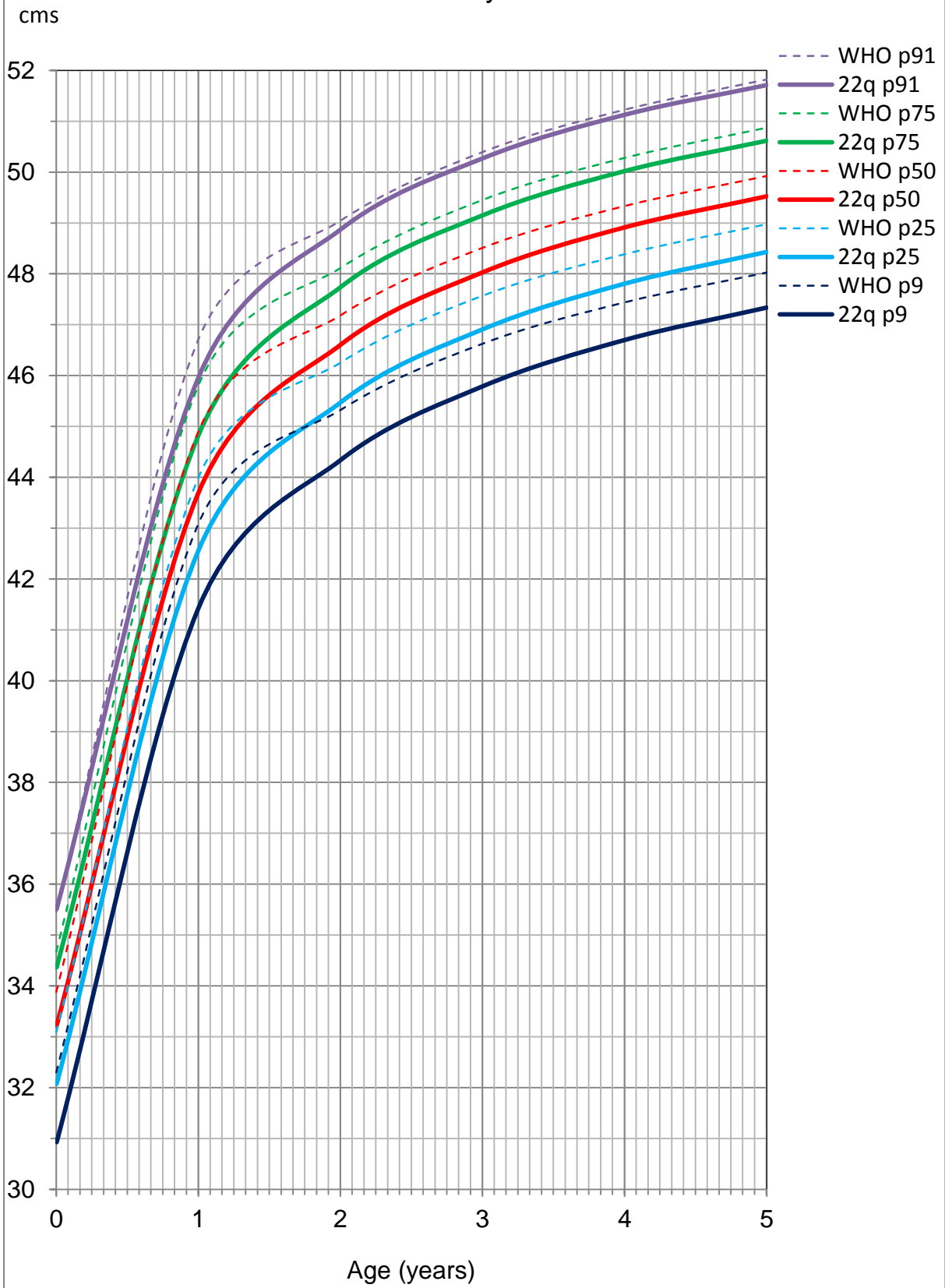
# Boys Head Circumference 22q11DS and WHO centiles Birth to 5 years

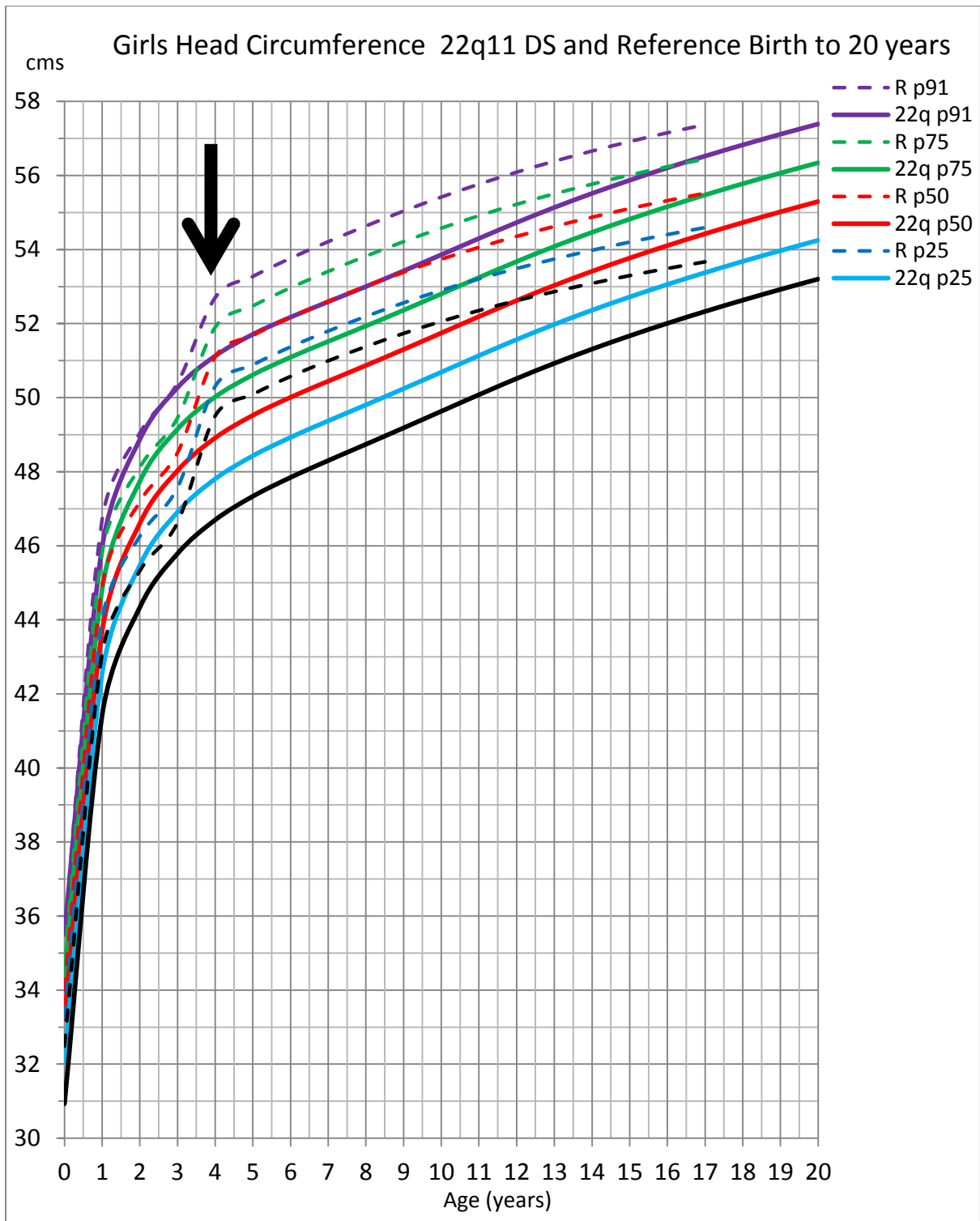




Arrow at disjunction between WHO and UK Reference values for head circumference
